Week 1: Monday, June 12th through Friday, June 16th

Zoo and Animal Week

Animals will be our focus this week. The children will make animal masks, construct a Zoo map and make necklaces with animal beads. Children will make animal puppets. A visit from either a petting zoo or an animal specialist will cap off our week.

Week 2: Monday, June 19th through Friday, June 23rd

Beach Week

The ocean and the beach will be the focus of this week. Children will make sun visors, picture frames decorated with seashells and sea creatures, sand art will also be featured. Ice Cream Sundae Day will only add to the fun. Water play, bubble play and a visit from Rockness music will complete our week.

Week 3: Monday, June 26th through Friday, June 30th

Dinosaur Week

This week will involve activities centered on dinosaurs. The children will go on dinosaur egg hunts, paint dinosaur footprints, make dinosaur fossils, and construct a dinosaur book. Dinosaur classification will also be a feature of this week.

Week 4: Monday, July 3rd through Friday, July 7th

Nature Week (Camp closed on Tuesday, July 4th)

Flowers, bumblebees, and bugs will be our focus. Children will plant a garden on our playground. They will construct their own "bug boxes", paint ladybug rocks and construct sun catchers. Terrariums will be constructed by the children. "Dirt Pudding" will be featured as a special treat.

Week 5: Monday, July 10th through Friday, July 14th

Space Week
